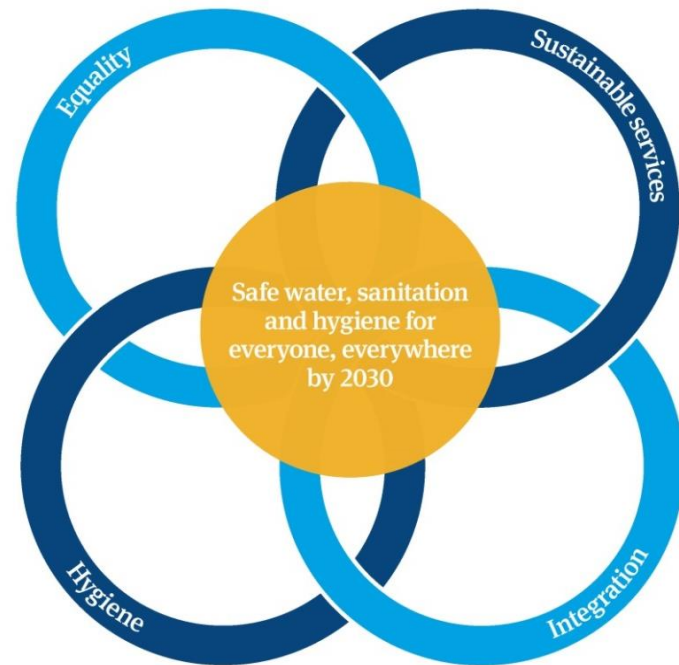


WaterAid UK: Global contributions for 2017/18

Our four aims are based on our assessment of how we can best influence change.



Equality

- Our programmes will strengthen their focus on marginalised people through a rights based approach
- Continue to develop expertise on gender sensitive and disability inclusive WASH

Sustainable services

- We will be a leading voice for WASH services that are sustainable as well as affordable
- We will work across the entire federation to assist the planning and reform needed to provide concrete guidance and practical examples to assist governments
- Our teams in West Africa will focus on programme quality, sustainability, influencing and advocacy to address inequality and sector strengthening

Integration

- We will focus on the links between water security and climate change, health and nutrition, education, and early childhood development
- Our teams in East and Southern Africa and South Asia will increase their focus on improved integration of WASH and climate change resilience

Hygiene

- We will push for increased prioritisation of investment in WASH as essential for human, social and economic development as a key public health intervention
- We will support continued engagement with midwives, nurses and doctors
- Our teams in Southern Africa will prioritise hygiene behaviour change
- The South Asia region will focus on Healthy Start and quality programmes
