



## INVITATION FOR BIDS FOR THE DRILLING & CONSTRUCTION OF BOREHOLES IN ZOMBA AND MANGOCHI DISTRICTS

CARE with support from the Bureau for Humanitarian Assistance (BHA) of USAID, in partnership with WaterAid Malawi, IFPRI, NASFAM, Emmanuel International, and Save the Children, is leading the implementation of the Titukulane Project whose goal is to achieve equitable, sustainable, and resilient food and nutrition security for 723,111 individuals in the communities in 20 Traditional Authorities in Mangochi and Zomba districts. Titukulane aims at, among other things, increasing the proportion of households with sustainable improved, or basic drinking water supply through increased coverage of safe drinking water in communities with below-basic access through targeted construction of boreholes.

WaterAid Malawi Internal Procurement Committee (IPC) therefore, invites sealed bids from eligible bidders who are registered in the **Borehole Specialists**, for the provision of borehole drilling and construction works as specified below.

1. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the open tendering procedures and is open to all interested bidders. A bidder shall be required to obtain a certificate of registration for the 2022/2023 financial year from the National Construction Industry Council in the Borehole Specialists.

3. Bidders are strongly encouraged to attend a **MUST** pre-bid site visit on **29<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> May 2023** starting with Zomba sites to familiarize themselves with the sites at their **OWN** costs.
4. Bids must be delivered to the address below at 5(a) **at or before 10:00 hours, 5<sup>th</sup> June 2023**. All bids must be accompanied by a bid securing declaration form. Late bids shall be rejected. Bids must be deposited in the tender box at the Administrative Assistant Office at WaterAid Malawi. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below at 5(a) at **10: 20 hours, on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2023**.
