Think about your responses to these questions, and use them as prompts to help create your artwork:

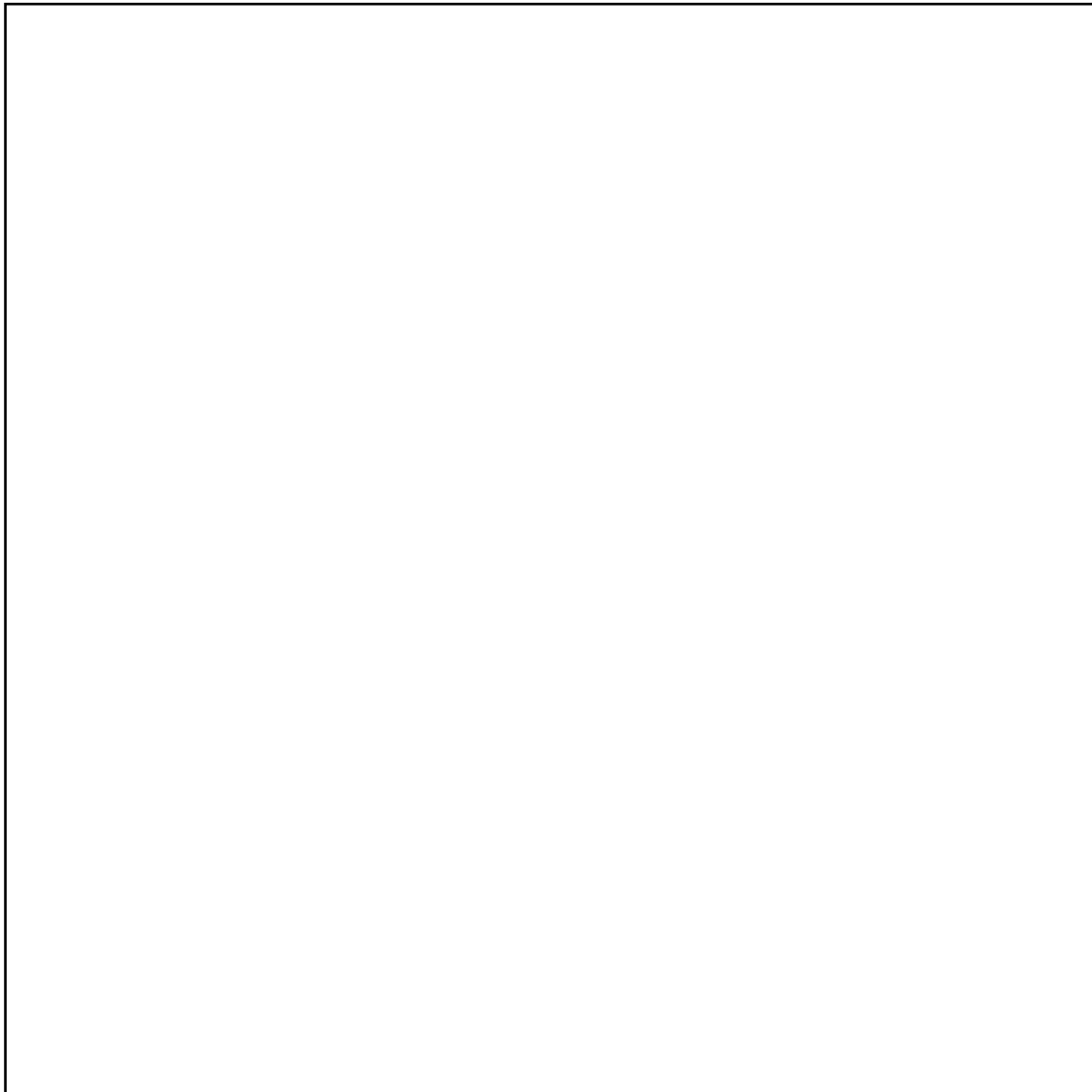
What does water and climate change mean to you?
