


## Christmas decorations

# Fundraising ideas



## Christmas collection

Hold a festive collection one Sunday during Advent.

## Nativity play

Ask the congregation to give a small donation to attend the children's Nativity play.

## Christmas feast

Hold a lunch or supper and ask for a small donation to attend. Ask guests to bring a different, homemade dish and share amongst everyone.

## Christmas fayre

If your church holds an annual Christmas fayre, why not ask your keenest bakers and crafters to create festive treats, decorations and gifts to sell in return for donations?

## Sing for water

Hold a carol concert and ask guests for a small donation in return for an evening of festive songs, mince pies and mulled wine.

## Add it on

For a quick and easy fundraiser, ask your congregation members to keep 50p aside for each Christmas gift they buy, to help us give the greatest gift of all – clean water.
