

Volunteer Deposit Terms & Conditions

To be accepted onto the 2019 WaterAid festival volunteer team, you must pay a deposit. Please carefully read the following agreement regarding this deposit. By applying for a place on the WaterAid festival volunteer team, I understand and agree that:

1. On accepting my volunteer place, I will pay a £50 deposit through the WaterAid website to confirm my volunteering position with WaterAid.
2. If I accept places at more than one festival in 2019, I will pay £50 per festival at the time of accepting my volunteer role for each festival.
3. I understand that WaterAid has the right to withdraw my volunteering offer(s) based on unsatisfactory references, and in this instance my deposit(s) will be returned to me.
4. My deposit(s) will be held securely in a WaterAid bank account.
5. Upon completing my volunteer role at each festival, in accordance with the volunteer agreement, I can choose to receive my deposit back or donate all/part of my deposit to WaterAid.
6. If I do not adhere to the volunteer agreement, WaterAid have the right to keep my £50 deposit after the festival. If I accept volunteering roles at more than one festival with WaterAid, this process stands for each festival.
7. If I choose to have my deposit refunded, I must inform WaterAid of my decision using the deposit refund form provided to me, no later than **30 days after the festival**, in order to process my refund. This process applies for each festival you volunteer at.
8. Where applicable, deposits will be refunded by BACS (bank transfer) from WaterAid into my bank account within 30 days of WaterAid receiving the deposit refund form.
9. If I have not submitted my deposit refund form to WaterAid by **30 days after the festival I volunteer at**, my deposit will be treated as a donation.
10. All deposits kept or donated to WaterAid will be directed to our general funds to support the organisation's charitable objectives - providing clean water and sanitation to the world's poorest people where it is needed most.
