These awards are to recognise schools that have gone above and beyond for WaterAid in 2017 and 2018. This competition is open to all schools that have donated to WaterAid since January 2017.

- The closing date for the awards is Friday 25 May at 11.59PM.
- To confirm that you would like your school to be considered further in the awards, you must complete the WaterAid School of the Year Entry form on the WaterAid website.
- Entries will be confirmed by email.
- By submitting the WaterAid School of the Year Entry form, you are confirming that you are aged 18 or over.
- WaterAid has the right to amend any rules and any rule changes will be sent to entrants via email.

Winners and prizes

- WaterAid will choose up to 6 schools to be crowned a WaterAid School of the Year. All winners will receive a framed certificate from WaterAid to recognise their achievements and a bespoke thankyou assembly presentation. One overall winner will also receive 10 x £10 book vouchers to be shared amongst pupils or used to buy books for the class or school.
- The prizes are non-transferable and non-refundable. No cash alternative is available.
- To enter the awards, you must complete the [WaterAid School of the Year Entry Form](#) on the WaterAid website.
- The winners will be notified by email on or before 8 June, and may also be publicly announced thereafter.
